



IN THE MATTER OF FOREST MANAGEMENT LICENCE NUMBER 6
AMENDMENT NO. 11

Whereas a right-of-way for the purpose of removal of forest products is required over the lands described hereinafter which said lands are within Forest Management Licence Number 6.

Therefore pursuant to Clause 15 of the said Forest Management Licence Number 6 the following is herewith withdrawn from the lands designated in Schedule "B" of the said Forest Management Licence that is to say the proposed logging road right-of-way 66 feet in width, commencing at a point on the west boundary of Timber Sale X70756 approximately 30 chains west and 20 chains south from the intersection of the east boundary of S.T.L. 11783^P with the north shore of Quatsino Sound, Rupert Land District; thence north-westerly a distance of 12 chains, more or less, to the south boundary of Timber Sale X70756, more particularly shown in red on the attached sketch, for the purpose of a right-of-way under Part VI of the "Forest Act" for the period necessary for the removal of forest products from Timber Sale X70756 or any extension or resale thereof and the lands so withdrawn are not and shall not be subject to the said Forest Management Licence for the period hereinbefore stated.

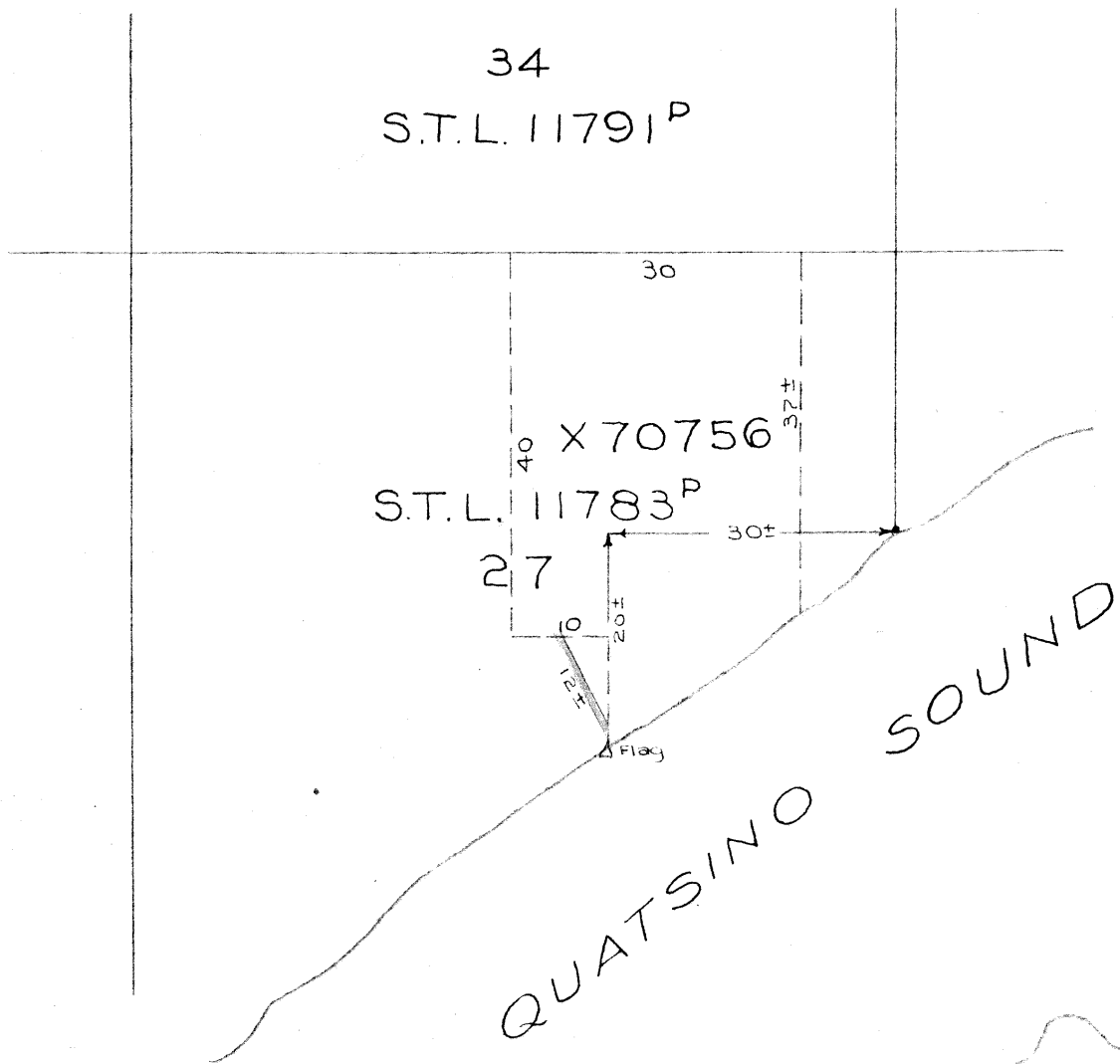
