IN THE MATTER OF FOREST MANAGEMENT LICENCE NUMBER 6


AMENDMENT NO. 13

Whereas Lot 2089 and Lot 2090 Rupert Land District, said to contain 39.3 acres, are within Forest Management Licence Number 6 and are found to be suitable for a higher economic use and whereas the withdrawal of the aforementioned lands in no way affects the sustained yield management of the said Forest Management Licence.

Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) of Section 33 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948 and Clause 17 of the said Forest Management Licence, the Licensor consents to the following lands being withdrawn from the said Forest Management Licence, being Lot 2089 and Lot 2090 Rupert Land District aforesaid and containing 39.3 acres more or less and the lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said Forest Management Licence. This Amendment cancels and replaces Amendment No. 12 dated the 13th day of January 1958.
