IN THE MATTER OF TREE FARM LICENCE NUMBER 6
AMENDMENT NO. 34

Whereas Lot 2137 Rupert Land District has recently been surveyed, and consists of part of Lot 190 Woodpulp Lease Number 1 shown in Schedule "A" and a portion of Crown land adjacent thereto shown in Schedule "B", and lies within Tree Farm Licence Number 6 and is required for higher economic use than the growing of forest crops.

And whereas pursuant to Clause 17 of the licence contract the licensee has requested the withdrawal from Schedule "A" of that portion of the said Lot 2137 lying within Schedule "A" containing approximately 470 acres and being part of Lot 190 Woodpulp Lease Number 1 mentioned above.

And whereas approximately 40 acres of the said Lot 2137 lies within the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said tree farm licence adjacent to the said Lot 190.


And whereas the withdrawal of the said lands in no way affects the sustained yield management of the said tree farm licence.

Therefore pursuant to Clauses 14 and 17 of the tree farm licence contract and pursuant to Subsection 14 of Section 36 of the Forest Act being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1960 the following described lands are hereby withdrawn from the Tree Farm Licence Number 6:

"Lot 2137, Rupert Land District and which is shown in red on the attached plan"

and the said lands are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said tree farm licence.
