AMENDMENT NUMBER 54

Whereas by a notice in writing under my hand dated the 28th day of November 1955 and designated Amendment Number 1 in the matter of Tree Farm Licence Number 6 certain lands were withdrawn from Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence, and

Whereas the aforementioned lands are no longer required for a higher economic use;


Therefore the said Amendment Number 1 is hereby cancelled and pursuant to subsection 14 of Section 36 of the *Forest Act*, being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1960, the following lands are herewith added to the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence;

"Commencing at the most southerly south-west corner of Section 13, Rupert, formerly Quatsino, Land District, being a point on the easterly high-water-mark of Atkins Cove; thence easterly along the southerly boundary of said Section 13 a distance of 4.5 chains; thence due north a distance of 4.25 chains; thence due west a distance of 7 chains, more or less, to the aforesaid easterly high-water-mark of Atkins Cove; thence in a general southerly direction along the said easterly high-water-mark of Atkins Cove to the aforesaid most southerly south-west corner of Section 13, being the point of commencement and containing 2 acres, more or less"

and the said lands are and shall be henceforth part of and subject to the said Tree Farm Licence Number 6.
