
AMENDMENT NO. 21

Whereas Lots 16071, 16072, 16073, 16074, 16075, 16076, 16077, 16078, 16079, 16080, 16088, 16089, 16090, 16091, 16092, 16093, 16094, 16095, 16101, 16111 and 16112 Kootenay Land District are within Tree Farm Licence numbered Twenty-three (23) and are found to be suitable for a higher economic use than for the growing of timber, and are in fact beyond the timber line near the top of a mountain, and whereas the withdrawal of the aforementioned lands in no way affects the sustained yield management of the forest.

Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) Section 33 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948 and pursuant to Clause 14 of the said Tree Farm Licence, being Lots 16071, 16072, 16073, 16074, 16075, 16076, 16077, 16078, 16079, 16080, 16088, 16089, 16090, 16091, 16092, 16093, 16094, 16095, 16101, 16111 and 16112 Kootenay Land District and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence.
