IN THE MATTER OF TREE FARM LICENCE NUMBER 23

AMENDMENT NUMBER 60

Whereas the lands described hereinafter are within Tree Farm Licence Number 23 and are found to be suitable for a higher economic use than the growing of forest crops.

And whereas the withdrawal of the aforementioned lands will in no way affect the sustained yield management of the said Tree Farm Licence.

Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) of Section 36 of the Forest Act being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1960 and pursuant to Clause 10 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 23 the following lands are hereby withdrawn from the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence that is to say all those lands situated within Kootenay Land District being more particularly shown outlined in red on the sketch attached hereto and described as follows:

"All vacant Crown lands within Blocks 1 to 34; 36 to 41; 50; and 55 contained within Lots 1140 and 1145, Plan 671B, Kootenay District, more particularly known as the Townsite of Ferguson".

And the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence.
