IN THE MATTER OF TREE FARM LICENCE NUMBER 23

AMENDMENT NUMBER 66

---

Whereas by a notice in writing under my hand dated the 9th day of January 1956 and designated Amendment Number 3 in the matter of Tree Farm Licence Number 23 certain lands were withdrawn from Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence for the purposes of a logging right-of-way for the removal of forest products;


And whereas the area so withdrawn was never developed for the said purpose and Special Use Permit Number 2521 covering the said area was subsequently cancelled on 6th day of May 1957;

Therefore the said Amendment Number 3 is hereby cancelled and the area so withdrawn by the said Amendment Number 3 being more particularly described as follows:

"The proposed logging right-of-way, 33 feet in width, lying between S.T.L. 3880<sup>P</sup> and Lot 871, Kootenay Land District, shown coloured red on the sketch attached hereto."

therefore remains within the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 23.
