IN THE MATTER OF TREE FARM LICENCE NUMBER 26

AMENDMENT NO. 4


Whereas part of Section 27, Township 18, New Westminster Land District, is within Tree Farm Licence Number 26 and is found to be suitable for a higher economic use than the growing of timber, and whereas the withdrawal of the aforementioned lands in no way affects the sustained yield management of the forest.

Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) Section 33 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948 and pursuant to Clause 9 of the said Tree Farm Licence the following lands are herewith withdrawn from the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence, namely all that parcel or tract of land situated in the New Westminster Land District, more particularly shown in red on the attached sketch and described as follows:

"Commencing at a point south 7.01 chains and west 7.76 chains from the northeast corner of Legal Sub-division 14 Section 27, Township 18, E.C.M; thence north 19° west a distance of 3.40 chains; thence north 86° 30' west a distance of 1.59 chains; thence south 3° 30' west a distance of 3.76 chains; thence north 81° 48' east a distance of 2.88 chains, more or less, to the point of commencement."

and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence.
