AMENDMENT NUMBER 12


Whereas by a notice in writing under my hand dated the 9th day of May, 1967, and designated Amendment Number 11 in the matter of Tree Farm Licence Number 26, the lands hereinafter described were withdrawn from the said Tree Farm Licence, and:

Whereas it has now been found that said notice designated Amendment Number 11 is defective and I hereby cancel the same and:

Whereas the lands described hereinafter are within Tree Farm Licence Number 26 and are found to be suitable for a higher economic use than the growing of forest crops and the withdrawal of the aforementioned lands will in no way affect the sustained yield management of the said Tree Farm Licence:

Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) of Section 36 of the Forest Act being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1960 and pursuant to Clause 9 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 26 the following lands are hereby withdrawn from the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence that is to say all those lands described as that part of the Fractional North half of Legal Subdivision 6, Section 8, Township 18, East of Coast Meridian, lying West of the Dewdney Trunk Road and containing 19 acres, more or less, and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence.
