AMENDMENT NO. 7


Whereas a right-of-way for the purpose of removal of forest products is required over the lands described hereinafter which said lands are within Tree Farm Licence Number 39.

Therefore pursuant to Clause 12 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 39 the following lands are herewith withdrawn from the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence that is to say a logging road right-of-way 40 feet in width being more particularly shown outlined in red on the attached sketch and described as follows:

"Commencing at a point on the northerly shore of Goliath Bay, Jervis Inlet, New Westminster Land District, said point being approximately 3 chains south and 18 chains east from the northeast corner of S.T.L. 33667; thence in a general northerly direction to the westerly boundary of Timber Sale X79102, together with logging spur roads to Timber Sales X85945 and X85982, totalling approximately 195 chains in length, save and excepting thereout that portion traversing Block 1 of X85982."

for the purpose of a right-of-way under Part VI of the "Forest Act" for the period necessary for the removal of forest products from Timber Sale X85982 or any extension or resale thereof and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence.
