AMENDMENT NO. 29

Whereas a right-of-way for the purpose of removal of forest products is required over the lands described hereinafter which said lands are within Tree Farm Licence Number 39.


Therefore pursuant to Clause 12 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 39 the following lands are herewith withdrawn from the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence that is to say a logging road right-of-way 40 feet in width being more particularly shown outlined in bold black on the attached sketch and described as follows:

"Commencing at a point on the northerly shore of Lois Lake, approximately 10 chains south and 15 chains east of the point of intersection of the north boundary of T.L. 961P with the northerly shore of Lois Lake, New Westminster Land District; thence in a general northeasterly direction to a point on the west boundary of T.L. 2004P approximately 10 chains north of the most southerly southwest corner thereof; together with loop road approximately at the point of commencement. Total length of road approximately 120 chains."

for the purpose of a right-of-way under Part VI of the Forest Act for the period necessary for the removal of forest products and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence showing the lifetime of Special Use Permit Number 5014.
