IN THE MATTER OF TREE FARM LICENCE NUMBER 39

AMENDMENT NO. 38

Whereas parts of Lots 1590, 3776, and S.T.L. 6273^P, all in New Westminster Land District, are within Tree Farm Licence Number 39 and are found to be suitable for a higher economic use than the growing of forest products.

Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) Section 36 of the Forest Act being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1960 and pursuant to Clause 11 of the said Tree Farm Licence, the following lands shown in bold black on the attached sketch and described as follows are herewith withdrawn from the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence:

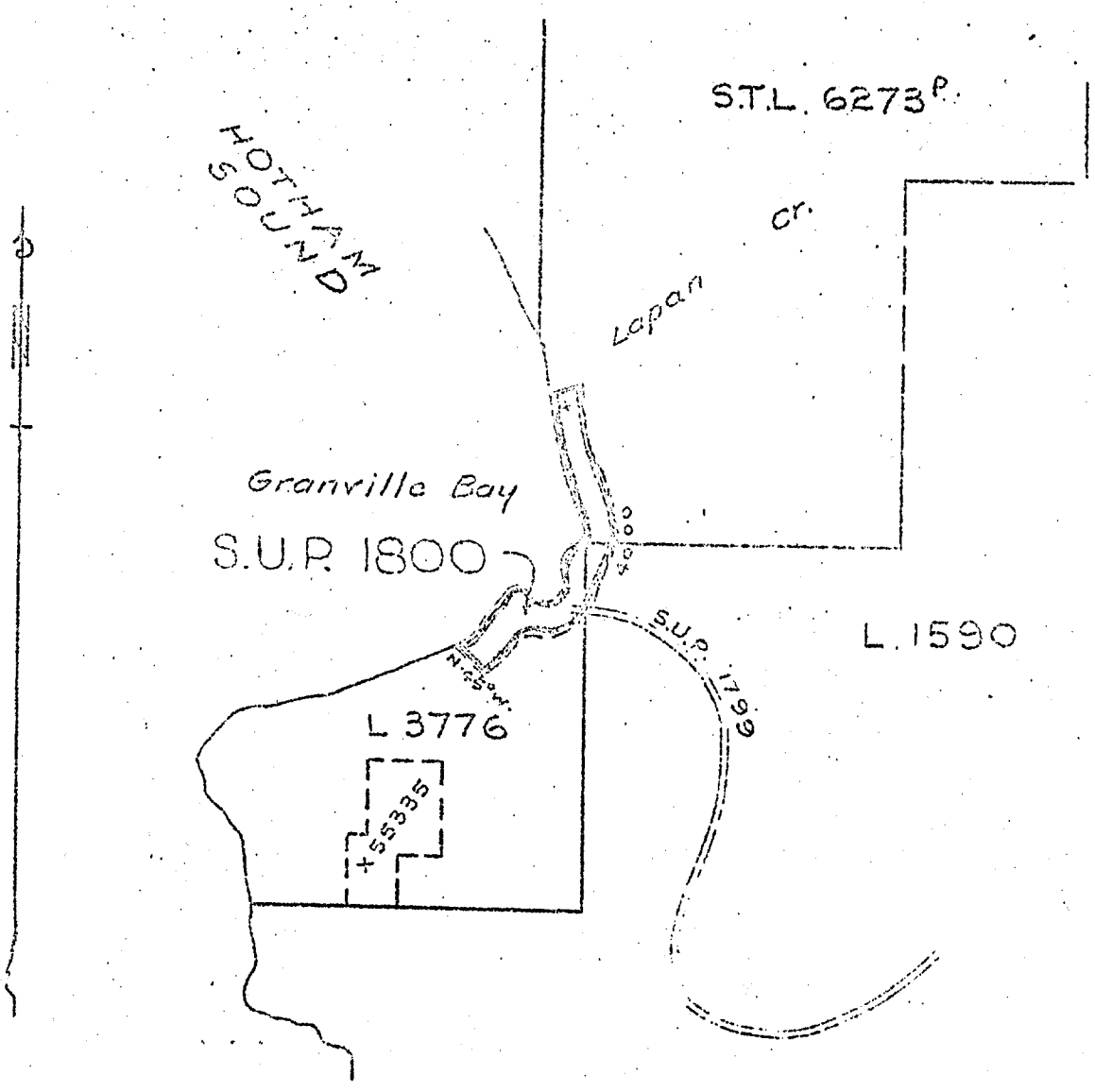
"Commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of S.T.L. 6273^P (expired) with the east shore of Granville Bay, Hotham Sound, Jervis Inlet, New Westminster Land District, thence northerly along the east shore of Granville Bay to the mouth of Lapan Creek; thence easterly along the south bank of Lapan Creek to a point 4 chains distant from the east shore of Granville Bay, thence southerly and southwesterly parallel to said shore 40 chains, thence north 45 degrees west to the shore of Granville Bay, thence northeasterly along said shore to point of commencement."

and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence during the life of Special Use Permit Number 1800.
