IN THE MATTER OF TREE FARM LICENCE NUMBER 39

AMENDMENT NO. 39

Whereas by a notice in writing under my hand dated the 10th day of March, 1964 and designated Amendment Number 36 in the matter of Tree Farm Licence Number 39, the lands therein described in the said Amendment Number 36 were withdrawn from the said Tree Farm Licence, and:

Whereas it has now been found that this said notice designated Amendment Number 36 is defective and I hereby cancel same, and:

Whereas a right-of-way for the purpose of removal of forest products is required over the lands described hereinafter which said lands are within Tree Farm Licence Number 39.


Therefore pursuant to Clause 12 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 39 the following lands are herewith withdrawn from the lands designated in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence that is to say a logging road right-of-way 40 feet in width being more particularly shown outlined in bold black on the attached sketch and described as follows:

"Commencing at a point on the east boundary of Lot 2255 New Westminster Land District, said point being 29 chains north of the southeast corner thereof; Thence in a general westerly, northerly, and easterly direction a distance of 12 chains, more or less, to the aforesaid east boundary of said Lot 2255."

for the purpose of a right-of-way under Part VI of the Forest Act for the period necessary for the removal of forest products and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence during the lifetime of Special Use Permit Number 2462.

This Amendment cancels and replaces Amendment Number 28 dated the 17th day of May, 1963.
