AMENDMENT NUMBER 68

Whereas the lands described hereinafter are within Tree Farm Licence Number 39 and are found to be suitable for a higher economic use than the growing of forest crops. (School-site)

And whereas the Licensee has requested the withdrawal of those parts of the lands which are included in Schedule "A" of the Licence;


And whereas the withdrawal of the aforementioned lands will in no way affect the sustained yield management of the said Tree Farm Licence.

Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) Section 36 of the Forest Act being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1960 and pursuant to Clause 14 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 39 the Licensor hereby consents to the withdrawal from Schedule "A" of the said Tree Farm Licence the following lands:

"Those parts of Section 18, Township 1 and Section 13, Township 2, Rupert Land District, containing 21 acres, more or less, shown colored bold black on the sketch attached hereto."


and the lands so withdrawn are not and shall not be henceforth subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence.
