LIST OF AMENDMENTS TO TFL 43

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TFL Boundary Changes

Since the award of T.F.L. 43 on January 1, 1985, the following boundary changes have been made:

Instrument #1 - Dated May 26, 1986

This instrument added 61.6 hectares of private land to the T.F.L. which was purchased by Scott Paper Limited, and was situated contiguous to the Fraser block of T.F.L. 43 near Popkum, B.C.

Instrument #2 - Dated May 26, 1986

This instrument added 59 hectares of Crown land to the T.F.L., and was located near the confluence of the Fraser and Harrison Rivers of the Fraser block.

Instrument #3 - Non-existent

Instrument #4 - Dated August 10, 1987

This instrument amended the boundaries of the Kingcome block of the T.F.L. to exclude Ecological Reserve No. 40.

Instrument #5 - Dated September 3, 1987

This instrument amended the Schedule "C" Kingcome block designation to allow for a Schedule "B" portion of the block, thereby giving access to Scott Paper to the Schedule "B" lands.

Instrument #6 - Dated October 21, 1988

This instrument added 38 hectares of Crown land to the Fraser block of the T.F.L., and were located near Rosedale and Popkum, B.C.

Instrument #7 - Dated November 15, 1990

This instrument apportioned 1,020 cubic meters of Schedule "B" annual allowable cut to the Small Business Forest Enterprise Program.

Instrument #8 - Dated July 3, 1992

This instrument converted the remaining Schedule "C" lands in the Kingcome block to Schedule "B".
