I am writing regarding Management Plan No. 2 for Tree Farm Licence 47.

A review of the operability mapping and 20-year plans for Blocks 13-14 (Courtenay) and Blocks 4-12 (Johnstone Straits) has been completed and are approved for use in the timber supply analysis for this management plan.

In the Courtenay portion of this tree farm licence, the fact that much of the land ownership in the Oyster River and Puntledge River watersheds is private creates some difficulty for us to assess the total impacts of forest management activities. In this regard, there have been some concerns raised about the overall rate of timber harvest and its cumulative effect on these community watersheds. It is expected that you will include this as an issue in the management plan along with a strategy to address the concerns.

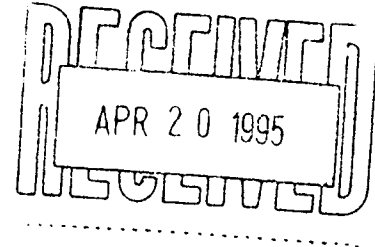
