## Summary

### a) MP 3 Initiation

No written response was received from the public to the viewing of MP 2. The public review period was from November 27 to December 27, 1998.

### b) Draft SMOOP

No written response was received from the public during the review period from July 21, 1999 to August 18, 1999.

### c) Draft MP 3

No written responses were received from the public as at February 9, 2001.



## **Stakeholders**

Letters were sent to all registered stakeholders inviting them to review the draft plan. The review period for comments was from October 23, 2000 to December 31, 2000. Three stakeholders, Columbia Shuswap Regional District, BC Hydro district office and the Mount Revelstoke and Glacier National Parks requested copies of the draft management plan from Louisiana-Pacific for review. No written responses were received from stakeholders.

## **Public Open Houses**

Open houses were held in Revelstoke on January 18, 2001 and in Malakwa on January 19, 2001 for the public to review the draft MP 3. Two members of the public attended the Revelstoke open house and no one attended the Malakwa open house. No written responses were received from the public to date. Written responses are being accepted from the public until February 18, 2001.

## **Agency/Licensee Comments**

No written comments were received from MELP, Parks Canada or other licenses operating in the vicinity of TFL 55.

## **First Nations**

Letters were sent to the Ktunasx/Kinbasket Tribal Council, Columbia Lake Band, Shuswap Nation Tribal Council and the Shuswap Band requesting comments on the draft management plan. No written comments were received.
