**Re: Notice of conservancy area deletions under section 60.2 of the *Forest Act***

The conservancies identified in column 1 of the Schedule in the attached deletion order were established under the *Protected Areas of British Columbia (Conservancies and Parks) Amendment Act, 2008*. The conservancies were brought into force on June 27, 2008, by B.C. Reg. 161/2008, as indicated in column 3 of the attached schedule. In accordance with section 11 (2.3) of the *Park Act*, this resulted in the deletion of Crown land included in the conservancies from Tree Farm Licences 25 and 39.

In accordance with section 60.501 (1) of the *Forest Act*, this letter is notice of the deletion of Crown land from Tree Farm Licences 25 and 39, the particulars of which are contained in the attached deletion order.

## Minister of Forests and Range Order

### *Forest Act, section 60.2*

In this order, “**conservancy**” means a conservancy named and described in Schedule E of the *Protected Areas of British Columbia Act*.

I, Pat Bell, Minister of Forests and Range, under section 60.2 of the *Forest Act*, order that Crown land in the conservancy identified in Column 1 of the Schedule below, effective on the date in Column 3 of the same item, is deleted from any part of a tree farm licence in Column 2 of the same item that, on that date, was within the boundaries of that conservancy.


The Crown land deleted by this order is to be used “for another purpose” as defined in section 60.1 of the *Forest Act*.
