Your Woodlot Licence Plan (WLP) submission of March 3, 2008, and as amended September 18, 2008, and November 26, 2008, for Woodlot Licence W0042 for the years 2009 to 2019 has now been fully reviewed.

Determination:

I am satisfied that the plan has been prepared and submitted in accordance with Section 13 of the *Forest and Range Practices Act* (FRPA) and the regulations. Accordingly, as the statutory decision-maker authority under Section 16 of the FRPA, I hereby am approving your WLP.

The Ministry of Forests and Range remains committed to a meaningful consultation process with First Nations who may assert traditional aboriginal interests in an area covered by this WLP. The particulars of this WLP have been communicated to the appropriate First Nations and their input has been encouraged. To date, I have not been advised of any site-specific aboriginal interests that may be infringed upon by the proposed development described in this WLP.

The term of this plan is January 15, 2009, to January 14, 2019. Further development taking place on Woodlot Licence W0042 must be done in accordance with the approved WLP. This letter forms an integral part of the WLP for Woodlot Licence W0042 and should be attached to it.
