Determination:



The particulars of this WLP have been communicated to the appropriate First Nations and their input has been encouraged. To date, I have not been advised of any site-specific aboriginal interests that may be infringed upon by the proposed development described in this WLP.

The term of this plan is June 16, 2011, to June 15, 2021. Further development taking place on Woodlot Licence W2002 must be done in accordance with the approved WLP. This letter forms an integral part of the WLP for Woodlot Licence W2002 and should be attached to it.
