Figure 1 - Seedling Requests by Species from Sowing Year 2010 to 202 - LBIS / FFT Funded

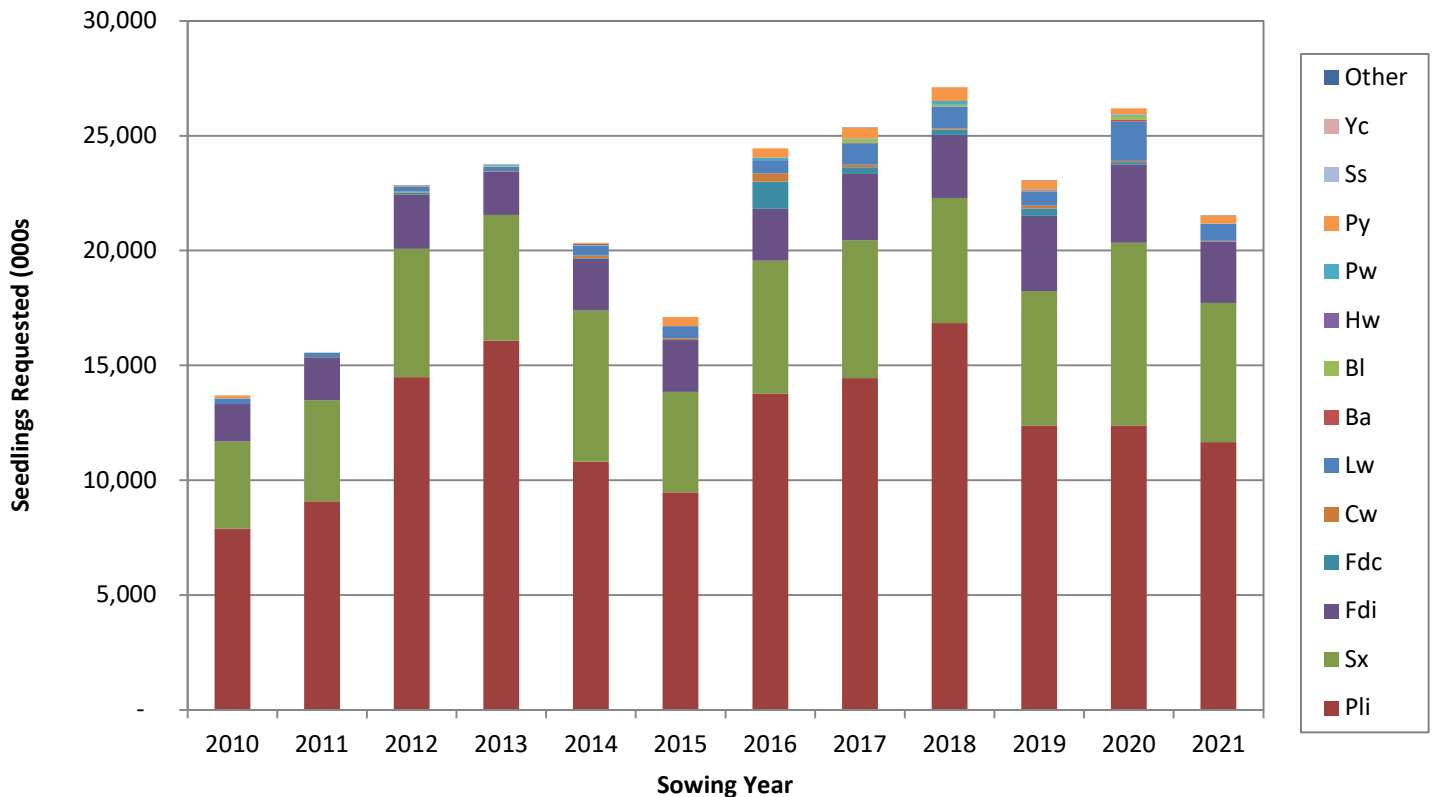
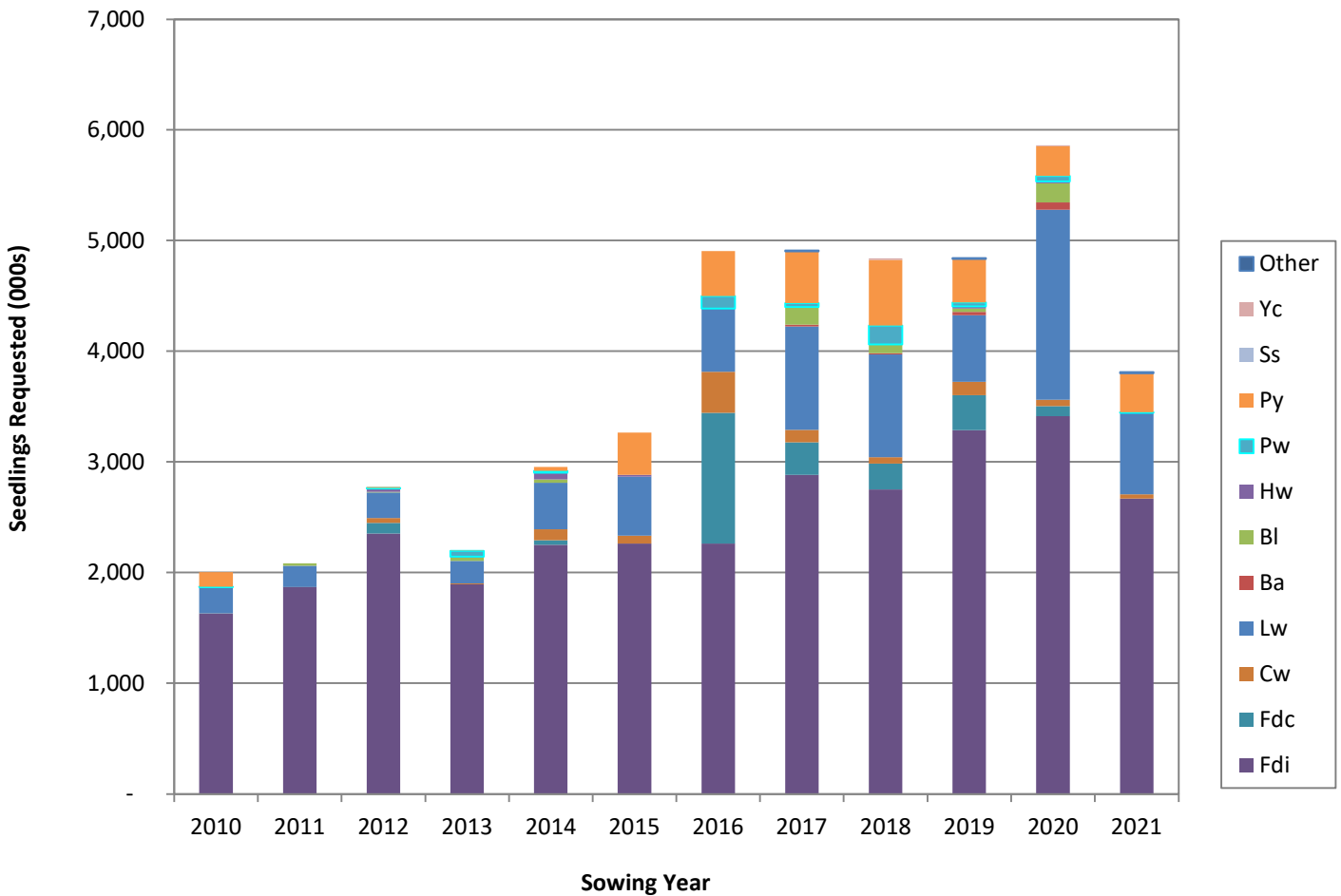


Figure 2 -Seedling Requests by Species (Pli and Sx removed) from Sowing Year 2010 to 2021 - LBIS / FFT Funded
