Dangerous Occurrences

<u>Dangerous Occurrences Reported for the Week of</u> <u>September 26th to October 2nd.</u>

- 1. Surface Mobile Equipment: A haul truck backed into the front of another haul truck.
- **2. Surface Mobile Equipment:** A haul truck coming down a ramp slid into a haul truck coming up the ramp.
- **3. Underground Mobile Equipment:** A fuel truck was driving up a ramp underground when it started to lose engine power and the operator noticed heavy smoke coming from the vehicle.
- **4. Surface Mobile Equipment:** A buncher was moving across a slope when one track drove over a stump causing the buncher to slip sideways. The buncher continued to slip down the slope for approximately 2 ft until it hit another obstruction.
- **5. Surface Mobile Equipment:** An idling light duty vehicle was left unattended and rolled away hitting an object and causing damage to the vehicle.
- **6. Surface Mobile Equipment:** A truck mounted boom crane was lifting equipment from the deck of a flatbed truck when the last boom slid out.
- **7. Surface Exploration:** A driller operator was moving a barrel when it slipped and pinched their finger, causing swelling and bleeding.

Comments: Follow the manufacturer's maintenance schedule for hoisting equipment. Know the safe limits of the hoist. For mobile cranes use level and load weight indicators and outriggers as required.
