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## Reportable Incidents

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### Incidents Reported for the Week of December 19<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup>

- 1. Surface Mobile Equipment Out of Control:** The operator of a light duty vehicle lost control through a corner in winter conditions. The air bag was deployed, and the driver sustained minor injuries.
- 2. Surface Blasting:** Post blast it was discovered that workers were within the 500m blast zone radius. They were missed in the pre-blast survey.

**Comments:** On November 30, 2022, changes to Code requirements for Reportable Incidents came into effect:

- 1.7.1(1) The following incidents are classified as dangerous occurrences and must be reported in accordance with section 1.7.2:
  - (a) an incident that causes serious injury or loss of life.
  - (b) an incident that had the potential to cause serious injury or loss of life.
- 1.7.1(2) In addition to an incident referred to in subsection (1), this section lists incidents that are also classified as dangerous occurrences and must be reported in accordance with 1.7.2.
