Reportable Incidents

Incidents Reported for the Week of January 9th to 15th, 2023

- 1. Surface Mobile Equipment Rollover:** A truck fell on its side when a load stuck in their box during dumping.
- 2. Surface Mobile Equipment:** Excavator swung into overhead power line.
- 3. Surface Geotechnical:** Unexpected movement of a pit wall. The area is blocked off to prevent access while under investigation.
- 4. Surface Mobile Equipment Collision:** A loader that was loading trucks backed into another loader moving through the pit.
- 5. Surface Blasting:** A dozer entered a tied in blasting pattern
- 6. Surface Mobile Equipment Rollover:** A truck mounted crane fell on its side.
- 7. Surface Mobile Equipment Collision:** A light duty vehicle entered the opposing lane of traffic. An oncoming fuel truck operator attempted to brake but their vehicle slid approximately 40m before making contact. Foggy conditions existed at the time of the incident.
- 8. Surface Geotechnical:** A double bench failure occurred in a pit.
