### Incidents Reported for the Week of February 13<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup>, 2023

- 1. Surface Mobile Equipment:** A loader had a fire near the back of the engine. The operator used the fire suppression system and called mine rescue.
- 2. Surface Operations:** A breaker operator noticed a fire on the roof; part of the scrubber was on fire. Mine rescue extinguished the fire.
- 3. Surface Operations:** A worker was hit by a pipe when it was being dragged by a pickup truck and got hung up on a berm and swung down hitting the worker and causing injuries to the lower body.
- 4. Public Incident:** A member of the public was injured while riding an offroad vehicle in a pit.

### Comments:

Unless authorized by the manager, no persons shall enter or leave a mine except by a recognized means of entry or exit. Ensure mine boundaries are well defined to prevent unauthorized access to a mine site.
