Weekly Summary of Dangerous Occurrences

Sharing safety with the mining industry



Dangerous Occurrences Reported for the Week of August 7th to August 13th 2023.

- **1.** Surface Mobile Equipment Fire: A fire started in the engine compartment of a haul truck. The onboard fire suppression system activated, and mine rescue attended to extinguish the fire.
- **2.** Surface Blasting, Misfire: A blasting primary assembly was found at a dump. It had not detonated but registered as fired on the blasting box.
- 3. Surface Geotechnical, Slope Failure: Cracks were observed in the area of a tailings storage facility.
- 4. Surface Mobile Equipment Collision: A loader backed into a flat deck truck.
- 5. **Surface**, **Other**: During the night, an unauthorized individual in a light vehicle accessed the mine property through the main site access. Staff intervened and returned the individual to security, where RCMP took custody of the individual. A full investigation has been initiated.

Comments: Unauthorized access to mine sites by individuals should be taken seriously; contact the local police for assistance when needed.
