Incidents Reported for the Week of November 20th to 26th, 2023.

- 1. **Surface Dam Erosion:** An erosion hole was identified during spillway repair work. Workers backfilled the hole with sand and geotextile.
- 2. **Surface Mobile Equipment Out of Control:** An autonomous haul truck spun 180 degrees while travelling down the ramp.
- 3. **Surface Fire:** Workers identified a fire at a compressor. The building was evacuated, and mine rescue attended while electrical isolation occurred.
- 4. **Underground Mobile Equipment Fire:** A loaded haul truck was travelling up the ramp when the operator noticed flames in the engine compartment. The operator parked the haul truck and noted that the flame was out.
- 5. **Underground Mobile Equipment Fire:** A scoop operator noticed flames in the engine compartment. A nearby worker used a fire extinguisher to extinguish the flames.
- 6. **Surface Mobile Equipment Fire:** A dozer operator noticed smoke on the left side of the engine bay, followed by flames. The operator exited the machine, and mine rescue responded.
- 7. **Surface Falling Objects:** A roofing crew was lifting a stack of roofing boards when a piece of dunnage that had frozen to the stack fell approximately 50 feet. It was a controlled area, but the spotter was about 26 feet away.

Comments: Ensure fire extinguishers are maintained and accessible. Each vehicle shall carry at least one fire extinguisher, in accordance with Code section 4.9.2.
