Reportable Incidents

Incidents Reported March 30th to April 5th, 2026

1. **Surface Other:** An excavator operator reported feeling unwell and experiencing numbness. The operator was transported for medical aid.
2. **Surface Mobile Equipment Rollover:** An excavator rolled over while working near the crest of a slope.
3. **Surface Working at Height Falling Workers:** An operator was applying grease on the top of an excavator and fell while descending. The operator was transported for medical aid and released the same day.
4. **Surface Blasting Explosives:** A Mobile Manufacturing Unit truck breached a loaded blast zone.
5. **Surface Working at Height Falling Workers:** While clearing a jam on a crusher conveyor belt, a worker fell approximately 2.4 metres to the ground. Mine rescue responded, and the worker was assessed for first aid and transported to medical care for knee injuries.
6. **Surface Mobile Equipment Unexpected Movement:** A parked, unattended light vehicle rolled approximately 3 metres before another employee entered the moving vehicle and brought it to a stop.

Comments: Ensure all parked vehicles are secured from moving before exiting. Attempting to re-enter an out-of-control vehicle presents a great risk to workers. Avoid re-entering out-of-control vehicles.
