

## ORDER OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

IN THE MATTER OF SECTIONS 13, 14, 19, AND 20 OF THE COAL ACT, S.B.C. 2004, CHAP.15, AND IN THE MATER OF SECTIONS 29, 42, 45, AND 50 OF THE MINERAL TENURE ACT, R.S.B.C. 1996, CHAP. 292

Under the authority vested in me pursuant to section 66 of the *Mineral Tenure Act*, I hereby extend the time limit for registering a statement of exploration and development, registering payment instead of exploration and development, registering a revised expiry date, or registering a rental payment, until December 31, 2021, for all mineral and placer mineral titles as described in the attached Schedule A.

Under section 6.36 of the *Mineral Tenure Act*, all time extensions in effect with a current expiry date prior to December 31, 2021 are hereby amended from their current expiry date to December 31, 2021.

Under the authority vested in me pursuant to section 27 of the Coal Act, I hereby extend the time limits for making an application to extend the term of a coal licence, and for making payment of rent for a coal lease until December 31, 2021 on every coal licence and coal lease as described in the attached Schedule A.

Under section 27 of the Coal Act, all time extensions in effect with a current expiry date prior to December 31, 2021 are hereby amended from their current expiry date to December 31, 2021.

- 4. All coal leases in existence as of the date of this Order:
  - a. and where the coal lease is not terminated,
  - b. and where the annual rental date of the lease is prior to December 31, 2021.
