

# Getting Started Online

What You Need to Acquire & Maintain Mineral Titles

## Free Miner Certificate (FMC)

- Provides clients with the right of free entry onto mineral lands, and to register mineral titles and other transactions in the registry.
- Download an [FMC application form](#)
- Register in person at a Service BC, FrontCounter BC, or Mineral Titles office.
- NOTE: Requires a yearly renewal fee. The first time fee must be paid by cash or cheque; subsequent payments are made online using Mineral Titles Online.



## Business BCeID

[www.BCeID.ca](http://www.BCeID.ca)

- Provides secure electronic access to government services, including Mineral Titles Online
- Verify your identity at any Service BC or FrontCounterBC
- NOTE: Individual FMCs still require a Business BCeID.  
Select **proprietorship** for the type of business and **no** for the business number during the enrolment process
