Mineral Titles Online (MTO) is an e-service and administrative tool that Mineral Titles clients use to acquire and maintain mineral and placer titles. MTO is also available to the public for searching for tenure information (using *maps* or *keyword searches*).

iMapBC is a self-serve web-based mapping tool for the Province that supports collaboration between government, industry and the public concerning natural resource information.

ILRR (Integrated Land and Resource Registry) provides access to legal interests on Crown land. Mineral Titles clients can perform land status for mineral/placer claims and run the *Landowner Notification Report*.

Web Map Services (WMS) provides access to the Province's geographic warehouse through connection links such as Google Earth's popular KML (Keyhole Markup Language) and industry standard WMS (Web Map Service). This provides users unprecedented access to provincial geographic information through a single Internet gateway.
