## Event Registration

*The title holder has **one year** from when the work was completed on the claims to register that work in MTO*

### Statement of Work (SOW)

On or before the expiry date of a claim, the title holder, or their agent, must register a summary of the work done on a claim in Mineral Titles Online (MTO). This will keep the claim in good standing for one or more years (up to 10 years from the current anniversary year). Registered work can be technical, physical, or a combination of both.

## Report Submission

*From the date when the SOW is registered in MTO, an assessment report in support of that work must be submitted within:*

- Technical Work: **90 days**
- Physical Work: **30 days**

**Include a copy of the SOW registration with your report.** If more than one SOW has been registered for the same work program, **include copies of all these related events** with your report.

**If you register an additional SOW after a report has already been submitted** (within one year of the completion date of the work) for which you have previously submitted a report, you **must inform the Mineral Titles office by phone or email**. We will need the original SOW event number to process your report and link it to the original report.

# Physical Report Requirements

## Physical Work Report Form

Use the template on the following webpage to create your report. The template asks for all the information that is required by legislation, except for the map and any additional supporting documentation that you wish to include.

Physical Reports must include, but not limited to:

### 1. Dimensions of work

For example, trenches or pits (in metric units)

### 2. Amount of material removed

In metric units

### 3. Actual dates work was performed on claim(s)

### 4. Qualifications/experience of operators

### 5. Map at the scale of 1:10 000 or better, showing where work was performed

### 6. Results

What commodities and amounts were found as a result of your exploration

### 7. Itemized Cost Statement

All costs must be itemized with an item description and how the item was calculated
