Free Miner Land Owner Identification

1. Use Mineral Titles Online (MTO - www.mtonline.gov.bc.ca) to determine if your Area of Interest (AOI) has any overlaps with the Crown Land Lease or Tantalus Surface Ownership information layer. These are located under the Tantalus Layers heading on the map. If there are overlaps please proceed to step 2.
2. Log On to the Integrated Land Resource Registry (ILRR - www.ilrr.ca) with your BCeID to run the **Business Report** for "Mineral Titles – Land Owner Notification". You can run this report via two options:
 - Select by Tenure Number – Enter your Mineral Tenure Number
 - Select by Area of Interest – **Don't forget to print your map after you define your AOI.**

SAVE and PRINT the report for your records.

3. Review the Report.
 - Part 1 – Crown Land Leases** – Lease owner(s) names and addresses will be listed if found
 - Part 2 – Private Land within Area of Interest** – Returns the PID and Legal Description to be used in BC Online
 - Part 3 – (Private Land) Possibly within the Area of Interest** – Contains records with PIDs and Legal Descriptions for areas that have no private land spatial (map) information
4. Logon to BC Online (<https://www.bconline.gov.bc.ca/>) to determine ownership of a private parcel found in Part 2 or Part 3 of the report. You will need a separate account with BC Online to access their services. Select one of the following options:
