ORDER OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER


WHEREAS, Victory Resources Corporation, the recorded holder of mineral claim title numbers 567126, 591361 registered technical exploration and development work pursuant to the mineral claims under Section 29 of the *Mineral Tenure Act* (the Act);

AND WHEREAS, Section 33(1) of the Act requires the recorded holder to submit a report in the form and manner prescribed by the Mineral Tenure Act Regulation (the Regulation) respecting this technical exploration and development;

I, Mark Messmer, Chief Gold Commissioner for the Province of British Columbia, order the reduction of the work credits recorded on event 5621127 based on the following:

- Section 16(3) of the Regulation requires that the report must be in the form and medium specified in Schedule A of the Regulation.
- Section 16(5) of the Regulation states that if the recorded holder fails to submit a report, as required under section 16(3) of the Regulation, the Chief Gold Commissioner may notify the recorded holder of the intention to cancel the registration of the recording of exploration and development under Section 33 of the Act.
- On October 05, 2016, exploration and development work was registered and recorded as per Mineral Titles Online event number 5621127.
- On April 20, 2017, a technical report was submitted under Mineral Titles Online event number 5621127 for the total applied work value of \$13,321.20.
- On September 26, 2017, you were advised by Mineral Titles staff that the report for Mineral Titles Online event 5621127 had been approved for the total value of \$6,000.

- For these reasons, the value of work applied to mineral claims is reduced by \$7,321.20.
