ORDER OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS, Carl Alexander Von Einsiedel, the recorded holder of mineral claim title numbers 1041355, 1024736, 844054, 1041357 registered technical exploration and development work pursuant to Section 29 of the *Mineral Tenure Act* (the Act);

AND WHEREAS, Section 33(1) of the Act requires the recorded holder to submit a report in the form and manner prescribed by the Mineral Tenure Act Regulation (the Regulation) respecting this technical exploration and development;

AND WHEREAS notice was given to the recorded holder of the intention to cancel the registration of the recording of exploration and development if a report in the form and manner prescribed by the regulations was not submitted;

AND WHEREAS the recorded holder has not submitted a report in the form and manner as prescribed by the regulations;

I, Mark Messmer, Chief Gold Commissioner for the Province of British Columbia, order the cancellation of the work credits recorded on event 5624281 based on the following:

- Section 16(3) of the Regulation requires that the report must be in the form and medium specified in Schedule A of the Regulation.
- Section 16(5) of the Regulation states that if the recorded holder fails to submit a report, as required under section 16(3) of the Regulation, the Chief Gold Commissioner may notify the recorded holder of the intention to cancel the registration of the recording of exploration and development under Section 33 of the Act.
- On November 01, 2016, exploration and development work was registered and recorded as per Mineral Titles Online event number 5624281.

- On April 27, 2017, you were advised by letter that the submitted report was not in the form and manner prescribed by the regulations. You were provided 30 days to submit an amended report.
- On June 14, 2017, you were advised by letter of the Chief Gold Commissioner's intention to cancel the registration of the recording of the exploration and development should the amended report not be submitted within 14 days of the date of the letter.
- On August 03, 2017, you were advised by letter that the submitted report was not in the form and manner prescribed by the regulations. You were provided 30 days to submit an amended report.
- On October 11, 2017, you were advised by letter of the Chief Gold Commissioner's intention to cancel the registration of the recording of the exploration and development should the amended report not be submitted within 14 days of the date of the letter
- To date, the amended report has not been received.
