**ORDER OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER**

WHEREAS, Clifford Henry Kohorst, the recorded holder of mineral claim title number 1095340, registered technical exploration and development work pursuant to the mineral claims under Section 29 of the *Mineral Tenure Act* (the Act);

AND WHEREAS, Section 33(1) of the Act requires the recorded holder to submit a report in the form and manner prescribed by the Mineral Tenure Act Regulation (the Regulation) respecting this technical exploration and development;


AND WHEREAS notice was given to the recorded holder of the intention to cancel the registration of the recording of exploration and development if a report in the form and manner prescribed by the regulations was not submitted;

AND WHEREAS the recorded holder has not submitted a report in the form and manner as prescribed by the regulations;

I, Donna Myketa, Chief Gold Commissioner for the Province of British Columbia, order the cancellation of the work credits recorded on event 5958103 based on the following:

- Section 16(3) of the Regulation requires that the report must be in the form and medium specified in Schedule A of the Regulation.
- Section 16(5) of the Regulation states that if the recorded holder fails to submit a report, as required under section 16(3) of the Regulation, the Chief Gold Commissioner may notify the recorded holder of the intention to cancel the registration of the recording of exploration and development under Section 33 of the Act.

- On November 14, 2022, exploration and development work was registered and recorded as per Mineral Titles Online event number 5958103.
- On May 10, 2023, you were advised by email that the report was submitted in the form of a physical work report and you were required to submit a technical assessment report in the form and manner prescribed by the Mineral Tenure Act Regulation.
- On May 30, 2023, you were advised by email of an intention to cancel the registration of the recording of the exploration and development work that the submitted report was not in the form and manner prescribed by the regulations. You were provided 14 days to submit a report.
- To date, the report has not been received.
