



## **Subject: Publication of Notice for an Application for Mining Lease**

Section 42(1)(c) of the *Mineral Tenure Act* requires that a notice must be published in the BC Gazette and once each week for 4 consecutive weeks in a newspaper circulating in the area in which the mineral claim is situated. Publication in the *Vancouver Sun* is also recommended.

The following box contains the required text of the applicable notice for publication in the BC Gazette and newspaper.
