ORDER OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS, Rudolph Roscher is a free miner and was issued free miner certificate number 110231472 on July 15, 2010, as registered in the Mineral Titles Registry;

AND WHEREAS, on June 3, 2016, the Chief Gold Commissioner served notice to Rudolph Roscher pursuant to Section 10(1) of the intention to cancel his free miner certificate;

AND WHEREAS, Rudolph Roscher did not request a hearing within 30 days from the date of service of this notice;

AND WHEREAS the notice of June 3, 2016 provided reasons and indicated that the Chief Gold Commissioner was satisfied that Rudolph Roscher has, with respect to the use and operation of a mineral title, contravened the *Mineral Tenure Act* and the *Mines Act*;

I, Mark Messmer, Chief Gold Commissioner for the Province of British Columbia, order the cancellation of Free Miner Certificate 110234172 and further order that Rudolph Roscher may not apply for another free miner certificate for a period of ten years from the date of this order and then may apply only on conditions the Chief Gold Commissioner may specify at that time.
