**ORDER: Section 10(2) of the *Mineral Tenure Act* (the Act)**

Dear Mr. Fuerstner:

On July 13, 2016, you were served a notice of my intention to cancel your Free Miner's Certificate.

Section 10(1)(b) of the Act says that within 30 days of a notice, you may request a hearing. This 30 day period has passed and you have not requested a hearing.

I am satisfied that you have contravened Section 10 of the *Mines Act*, as well as orders issued to you on September 3<sup>rd</sup> and September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2015 with respect to mining activity you were conducting on placer claims 360599, 360600, and 360601 and placer leases 519736 and 513882.


For these reasons, and pursuant to Section 10(2) of the Act, I order the cancellation of your free miner certificate as of this date for an indefinite period of time. You may only apply for another free miner certificate on terms and conditions as may be specified by the Chief Gold Commissioner.
