ORDER OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS, Canada Rockies International Investment Group Ltd. (CRIIG) is a free miner and was issued free miner certificate number 110249004 on September 7th, 2018, as registered in the Mineral Titles Registry;

AND WHEREAS, the Chief Gold Commissioner served notice pursuant to s.10(1) of the Act on November 14, 2018 to CRIIG;

AND WHEREAS, CRIIG requested a hearing within 30 days from the date of service of the notice;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was conducted in-person on January 26, 2019 with Mr. Yong Chang Chen, the owner and president of CRIIG, Ms. Cyfloel Hui, Ms. Jill Pardoe, agent for CRIIG, Andrea Ross, Senior Mines Inspector, Mark Messmer, and Ms. Tracy Martin, Titles Technician;

AND WHEREAS CRIIG was provided with a record of the hearing minutes, a summary of non-compliance records that were documented in a number of inspection reports previously issued to CRIIG for action and remediation, and was given an opportunity to respond in writing to the summary of non-compliances report;

I, Mark Messmer, Chief Gold Commissioner for the Province of British Columbia, order the cancellation of Free Miner Certificate 110249004 and further order that Canada Rockies International Investment Group Ltd. and Mr. Yong Chang Chen may not hold or apply for a free miner certificate for a period of two years from the date this order is signed and then may apply only on conditions the Chief Gold Commissioner may specify at that time.
