The undersigned has the honour to

report that a reservation upon all minerals in the lands described in Order-in-Council No. 953, approved on the 2nd day of May 1949, is no longer needed.

And to recommend that the said Order-in-Council No. 953, approved on the 2nd day of May 1949, be rescinded.

And to further recommend that pursuant to sub-section (5) of section 14 of the "Mineral Act", chapter 213, S.S.B.C. 1940, a reservation be placed on all minerals, in the New Westminster Mining Division, New Westminster Land Recording District, in a strip of land 500 feet wide, being 250 feet on each side of the centre line of lot 1767, from the westerly shore of Vanlocch lake, westerly to the easterly boundary of Tr. W. L.S. 13.

And that the undersigned, Minister of Mines do sign an order to that effect.
