The undersigned has the honour to REPORT THAT the Department of Resources and Development Canada has requested that a mineral reserve be placed upon the lands described in Schedules "A", "B", "C" and "D" attached hereto in the Kootenay Land District:

SCHEDULE "A"

(Lands conveyed by the Corporation of the City of Revelstoke to Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada for the purposes of an addition to Mount Revelstoke National Park, as described in Certificate of Indefeasible Title, Nos. 91423-I and 91424-I).

(1) Legal Subdivision Fifteen (15) and those parts of Legal Subdivision Seven (7), Ten (10), Eleven (11), Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14), of Section thirty-four (34), Township Twenty-Three (23), Range Two (2), West of the Sixth (6th) Meridian, Kootenay District, which lie to the north and East of Five Seven Hundred and Sixty-Five (765), and to the North and East of a line drawn parallel to and distant twelve and Twelve One-Hundredths (12.12) chains Northerly from the Northerly boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company's right-of-way as shown on Plan One Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty-Two (1382) and to the East of the Easterly Boundary of Villa Lots Forty-one (41) and Forty-two (42) Plan A - Nineteen (A-19) and its production Southerly, and Save and Except thereout that part shown outlined in red on Sketch Plan 4252-I.

(2) Legal Subdivision Three (3) and that part of Legal Subdivision Six (6) of Section Three (3), Township Twenty-four (24), Range Two (2), West of the Sixth (6th) Meridian, Kootenay District, lying South of the Easterly production of the Northerly boundary of Villa Lot Sixty-Eight (68).

SCHEDULE "B"

(Lands conveyed by John Ross Bailey to His Majesty the King in right of Canada for the purposes of an addition to Mount Revelstoke National Park, as described in Certificate of Indefeasible Title, No. 76872-I.)

That part of the South West quarter (S.W. 1/4) of Section Three (3), Township Twenty-four (24), Range Two (2), West of the Sixth (6th) Meridian, Kootenay District, lying north of the Easterly production of the Northerly boundary of Villa Lot Sixty-eight (68) and East of the Northerly production of the Easterly Boundary of the said Villa Lot Sixty-eight (68).
