The undersigned has the honour to recommend that pursuant to Sub-section 1 of Section 16 of the "Placer-mining Act", Chapter 214, Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the following described lands in the Nanaimo Mining Division, namely:

All of the lands and premises between the Kokish River and the logging road to the east of the River between the southerly boundaries of Lot 2 and Lot 348 and the northerly boundary of Lot 580:

And the west half of Lot 580:

And all the lands and premises of all that area in the Ida Lake and Bonanza Lake drainage basins including all connecting and tributary streams and lakes lying upstream from the southerly boundary of Lot 580 below an elevation of nine hundred (900) feet (assuming mean highwater of Bonanza Lake to be at an elevation of eight hundred seventy-five (875) feet).
