The undersigned has the honour to recommend that pursuant to Sub-section 1 of Section 16 of the "Placer-mining Act", Chapter 214 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the following described lands in the Revelstoke, Slokan, Trail Creek and Nelson Mining Divisions, namely:

All those lands, situated in Kootenay Land District being more particularly described as


"All those lands lying below the 1425 foot contour bounding the Upper Arrow Lake, Lower Arrow Lake, and that part of the Lower Columbia River lying to the north of the International Boundary and all tributaries thereof."
