recommend pursuant to Section 14 (5) of the "Mineral Act", and Section 16 (1) of the "Placer-mining Act", chapters 213 and 214 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948, respectively, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the following areas in the Alberni Mining Division, namely:

(1) In all lands surrounding Elsie Lake and drainage tributary thereto lying below the 1100 foot contour of elevation; and

(2) In the land lying between Great Central Lake on the south and Ash River and Elsie Lake on the north and bounded on the east by 125 degrees and 8 minutes of west longitude and on the west by 125 degrees and 10 minutes of west longitude; and

(3) In the land surrounding Great Central Lake and drainage tributary thereto lying below the 300 foot contour of elevation, including the drainage from the lake for a distance of one-half mile below the outlet of the said lake; and

(4) In a strip of land one mile wide between Sproat Lake and Great Central Lake and the drainage from the lake, lying to the west of a line drawn due north from the mouth of Shuhum Creek for eight-tenths of a mile, thence north 43 degrees west to a point on the drainage outlet of Great Central Lake one-half mile below the outlet of the said lake; and

(5) In the lands lying on each side of Sproat River for 1000 feet from each margin of the said River between Sproat Lake and the Stamp River and Somass River, respectively.
