The undersigned has the honour to recommend pursuant to Section 14 (5) of the "Mineral Act", and Section 16 (1) of the "Placer-mining Act", chapters 213 and 214 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948, respectively, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the Liard Mining Division along the valley of Bass Creek and all tributaries thereto and Simmons and other lakes draining into Bass Creek for a distance of one-half mile on either side of the centre line of Bass Creek and of the tributaries and lakes draining into it, as shown on the attached map.
