The undersigned has the honour to recommend pursuant to Section 14 (5) of the "Mineral Act", and Section 16 (1) of the "Placer-mining Act", chapters 213 and 214 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948, respectively, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the Skeena Mining Division in the following lands:

All lands in the valley of the Bell-Irving River and its tributaries lying below the 1500-foot contour of elevation upstream from the point at which the 1000-foot contour of elevation intersects the said Bell-Irving River; and

All lands in the valley of the Bell-Irving River and its tributaries lying below the 2000-foot contour of elevation upstream from where 56 degrees and 27 minutes of north latitude crosses the valley of the said Bell-Irving River.
