

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

Res. No 2324/59

The undersigned has the honour to recommend that pursuant to Sub-section 5 of Section 14 of the "Mineral Act", Chapter 213 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the following described lands in the Nanaimo Mining Division, namely:

All those lands, situated in the Sayward Land District, being more particularly described as

"Commencing at the northwest corner of Lot 165, Sayward Land District; thence due west for a distance of two miles; thence due south for a distance of one and one half miles; thence due east for a distance of two miles more or less to a point due south of the point of commencement; thence north for a distance of one and one half miles more or less to said point of commencement."

AND THAT the undersigned Minister of Mines do sign an order to that effect.
