The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to recommend that pursuant to Section 14 (5) of the "Mineral Act", and Section 16 (1) of the "Placer-mining Act" Chapters 213 and 214 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1946, respectively, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the following areas in the Liard, Omineca and Cariboo Mining Divisions, namely:

The valley of the Peace River and its tributaries lying below the 2,000 foot contour of elevation, upstream from 121 degrees 55 minutes of west longitude to Finlay Forks; and the valley of the Finlay River and its tributaries below the 2,800 foot contour of elevation upstream from Finlay Forks to Ware; and the valley of the Finlay River and its tributaries below the 3,000 foot contour of elevation upstream from Ware; and the valley of the Farnip River and its tributaries below the 2,500 foot contour of elevation upstream from Finlay Forks southerly to 55 degrees of north latitude.

AND THAT the undersigned Minister of Mines do sign an Order to that effect.
