LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR

recommend that pursuant to Section 14 (5) of the Mineral Act, Chapter 213, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, and Section 16 (1) of the Placer-mining Act, Chapter 214, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, a reservation be placed upon all Crown minerals within the area described as follows:

commencing at a point on the South Nanaimo River at the northwest end of the Nanaimo City Water Reservoir and embracing all the watershed area of the said River above the said described point as shown on the map attached hereto.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT pursuant to Section 14 (6) of the Mineral Act and Section 16 (2) of the Placer-mining Act the reservation outlined above be cancelled subject to the following terms: that no person shall have the right to enter, prospect, locate or mine upon any of the lands referred to herein except with authority granted pursuant to the Health Act, being Chapter 141, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948.

AND THAT the Minister of Mines do sign an Order to that effect.
